DISAPPROVAL

JUSTIFICATION FOR APPROVAL OR DISAPPROVAL:

The request for exemption was unanimously approved by a vote of 6 to 0. The committee found that the merits of the proposed research and its potential benefits clearly outweigh the disadvantages of the restrictions on access by foreign scholars and restrictions on access to campus facilities: the research will utilize unique university resources, have very substantial educational benefits, and constitute a very substantial public service.

The committee also notes that the request does not involve indefinite delay of open publication of the results of research but only publication of restricted/proprietary information provided to the investigator.
